

PRIVACY STATEMENT

pursuant to art. 13 of the Leg. Decree 196/03 and according to the REG UE 679/2016



Pursuant to article 13 of the “Personal data protection code” of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 and following the EU’s new data privacy law called General Data Protection Regulation No. 679/2016 that goes into effect on May 25, 2018, according to the art. 13’s disclosures from the above mentioned European Law, we hereby inform you the followings:

Purpose of personal data processing:

Your personal data, freely communicated and collected by us in the scope of SAMEC S.r.l.’s activity, will be processed within the limits and under the law terms for the following purposes: services supply, way billing and invoicing, technical assistance, complaints and/or disputes management, prevention/repression of any illegal activity or fraud attempt, communications related to the contractual relationship established.

Personal data processed (which may be common or identifying, not sensitive nor judicial) are updated, relevant, complete and do not exceed the above listed purposes for which they are collected and subsequently processed.

With regard to the sensitive data, please note that their meaning is: “any personal data that revealing racial and ethnic origins, religious, philosophical or other beliefs, political opinions, parties, labour unions, associations or religious, philosophical, political or labour organizations, as well as personal data that reveal the state of health and the sexual life.”

The meaning of judicial data is: “the personal data that can reveal provisions pursuant to art.3, paragraph 1, letters from a) to o) and from r) to u), of Presidential Decree No. 313/2002, concerning the criminal records, the register of administrative penalties depending on the type of offence and the related pending charges, or the status of indicted or investigated pursuant to articles 60 and 61 of the penal procedure code. Other purposes are led to the ordinary administrative activities.

Processing methods:

The data will be processed, in compliance with the necessary security and confidentiality, by following the below listed procedures: data collection from the involved subject, data registration for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes and employed in further processing operations in compatible terms with these purposes. The data processing activity has been carried with the aid of electronic devices and automatic tools (service management platform).

Legal grounds of data processing:

The legal ground of your personal data processing is based on the contracting of the goods and/or services requested by you or clearly provided by the national regulation in the business relationship matter.

Legitimate interests pursued by the Data controller:

The legitimate interests pursued by the Data controller while processing it is given by the obligation to respect and honour the contractual obligations signed by the parts involved. Pursuant to art. 6 the lawfulness of the data processing is based upon the expressed consent from behalf of the involved part, documented by a written form.

Mandatory or optional nature of data transfer and the consequences of the refusal to answer:

The nature of the data transfer from your side is mandatory in order to allow to the data controller to provide you the requested goods and services. Therefore, in case of refusal, it will be impossible to complete the registration process and the system owner will not be able to fulfil the contractual obligations.

Data communication to third parties:

Your personal data will be treated by the Data controller, by the person in charge appointed by him and by the strictly authorized personnel.

Your data may be disclosed as a result of inspections and examinations (if required), to all inspection authorities that are in charge of examinations and controls concerning the regularity of the legal obligations.

Your data may also be disclosed to companies / professional offices that provide assistance, advice or collaboration to the data owner, in accounting, personal data register, administrative, tax, legal and financial matters, to public administrations for the performance of institutional functions within the limits established by law or by the rules and to third-party service suppliers to whom the data communication is necessary for performing the services covered by the contract. Your personal data are not subjected to disclosure.

Preservation time:

Your personal data will be preserved for 10 (ten) years after the end of the business relationship.

A data subject can exercise any time the rights reserved to him and ratified by the art. 7 from the Legislative Decree 196/03 and art. 15 from the European Law No. 679/2016, we hereby report the full text of.

Legislative Decree No. 196/03 - Art. 7. Right to Access Personal Data and other Rights

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form. 2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed a) of the source of the personal data; b) of the purposes and methods of the processing; c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means; d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2); and e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing. 3. A data subject shall have the following rights:

a) to obtain updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
b) to obtain erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;

c) to obtain certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected. 4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part, a)

on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.

Reg EU 679/2016 - Article 15. Right of access by the data subject

1. The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and the following information: (a) the purposes of the processing; (b) the categories of personal data concerned; (c) the recipients or categories of recipient to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular recipients in third countries or international organisations; (d) where possible, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period; (e) the existence of the right to request from the controller rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning the data subject or to object to such processing; (f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority; (g) where the personal data are not collected from the data subject, any available information as to their source; (h) the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) and, at least in those cases, meaningful information about the logic involved, as well as the significance and the envisaged consequences of such processing for the data subject. 2. Where personal data are transferred to a third country or to an international organisation, the data subject shall have the right to be informed of the appropriate safeguards pursuant to Article 46 relating to the transfer. 3. The controller shall provide a copy of the personal data undergoing processing. For any further copies requested by the data subject, the controller may charge a reasonable fee based on administrative costs. Where the data subject makes the request by electronic means, and unless otherwise requested by the data subject, the information shall be provided in a commonly used electronic form. 4. The right to obtain a copy referred to in paragraph 3 shall not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others.
